Purbury eight yerdys between the walls of the East end of my house
or rather a dyke pringe upon the dwelling house of Anne Shaws widow
in Newham aforesaid for a lodgyng place for him, and one way to the gate
in the same pasture of Newham aforesaid during his naturall life
But if he shall without lett or lett the premises or any part thereof
then he shall receive no benefit at all thereof but the same shall
descend and come to my said daughter Margaret and her heirs I have
given and bequeath to my said brother Ralph Purbury one blacke
nether purre and will is that no division be made of my said
betwixt my said wife and my daughter, but shall be equally valued
and my said wife to receive her proportion of the profits or revenue
of that part of my lands that shall be pleased before my said daughter
come to years of discretion or she married upon forfeiture of five
shillings an acre for Anne to be paid by him or them that shall
inherit the same to the use of my said daughter I have given and
bequeath to my sister Anne Judson 20 s I have given bequeath
to my goddaughter Margaret Judson 10 s And to all the rest of
my sister Judson children six s eight pence a year I have given
and bequeath to my nephew Christopher Purbury my brother
Francis his share 10 s And to his daughter Margaret Purbury
6 s 8 d I have given and bequeath to my brother Thomas Purbury
his two children 20 s a piece I have given and bequeath to
Christopher Reed and James Felton two poore boys 12
s a piece And of this my last will and testament I do hereby
ordaine and appoint Gabriel Purbury my said wife sole Executrix
Shawe senior of Newham yeoman my brother Francis Purbury
and Robert Ripplm of Gayles to be Supervisors of the said will
Entire for my said daughter and her portion, to see her brought up
in her marriage and receive arridginge to her qualite meaning degree
And that they wilbe pleased to make all former together one or
twice every year duringe my daughters minoritye to make
their strength some time the premises at what time or times
doe allowe them two shillings for their charge to be defalced
out of my said daughters meaning In witness whereof I the said

day and year first above written Christopher Purbury
